OUR SPEAKER

Sir Iain Lobban KCMG CB, Director, GCHQ

Iain Lobban was appointed GCHQ Director in July 2008.

He is responsible to the Foreign Secretary for the management of GCHQ including control of intelligence and security operations in the UK and abroad, and through the Cabinet Secretary for the effective and economical management of the resources allocated to the department. GCHQ's Signals Intelligence (Sigint) and Information Assurance (IA) missions are applied in support of national security, of the prevention and detection of serious crime and of economic wellbeing.

Iain joined GCHQ in 1983. As Director, he focuses on GCHQ's contribution to customer outcomes, ensuring that our cutting-edge technological capability can be harnessed across the range of UK national security objectives from counter-terrorism through foreign policy to defence; sustaining capability – whether technology

or people – specifically through excellence in programme delivery and upskilling; and running the business, particularly good governance (where GCHQ received the highest baseline Capability Review in 2009) and in innovative leadership thinking after the London bombings.

In 2001, Iain attended the Higher Command and Staff Course at the Joint Services Command and Staff College.

Iain routinely spends Tuesdays to Thursdays in London, briefing Ministers, attending the Joint Intelligence Committee and participating in other Permanent Secretary level meetings.

Born in Nigeria in 1960, Iain was educated in Crosby, Lancashire and read French with German at the University of Leeds.
