ORDER

UPON HEARING Leading Counsel for the Claimant and Leading Counsel for the Defendant

IT IS ORDERED that:

- Permission to apply for judicial review is granted in respect of all the grounds advanced by the Claimant.
- 2. The case shall be set down for a substantive hearing to be heard before 1 February 2017, with an estimated length of hearing of 3 days ("the Hearing").

The Hearing is to be listed after consultation with the clerks to counsel for the Claimant and the Defendant.

- 3. The case shall be listed before a Divisional Court, with a Lord or Lady Justice of Appeal sitting with a High Court Judge.
- 4. The Defendant shall file and serve Detailed Grounds of Defence by 4 pm on 5 August 2016.
- 5. Subject to any applications the Defendant may make for public interest immunity and/or a Closed Material Procedure in accordance with Section 6 of the Justice and Security Act 2013 ("the 2013 Act"), the Defendant shall file and serve any evidence on which it seeks to rely by 5 August 2016.
- 6. The Defendant shall, no later than 5 August 2016, also inform the Claimant and Court:
 - (a) whether it proposes to apply for Public Interest Immunity in respect of any evidence on which it proposes to rely; and
 - (b) whether it proposes to apply for a Closed Material Procedure pursuant to Section 6 (2) of the 2013 Act.
- 7. If the Defendant proposes to make an application for Public Interest Immunity and/or a Closed Material Procedure, any such application must be made by 30 September.
- 8. The Clamant shall, if so advised, file and serve any further evidence on which it proposes to rely by 3 October 2016
- 9. The Defendant has permission to file and serve further evidence in rebuttal.
- 10. Liberty to apply.

Protective Costs Order and Costs Capping

- 11. The Claimant's costs liability, if any, in these proceedings shall not exceed £40,000 in total.
- 12. The Defendants' liability, if any, in respect of costs incurred by the Claimant in these proceedings shall not exceed £70, 000.
