Casting a dark shadow across our capital, the Italian arms company designs and manufactures the critical laser targeting system for the F-35 fighter jet programme at their Scottish base on Crewe Road North in Edinburgh.



Darchem Engineering

Supplying both fabrication assemblies and insulated components for the F-35 programme, this company has an office on Morrison Street in Edinburgh.



Raytheon Technologies

Making the Paveway IV Guided Missiles in Glenrothes at the Queensway Industrial Estate and the Paveway II Guided Missile, used by Israel, in the US - the supply chain for these missiles is unclear, but ultimately, the same multinational company has responsibility.



BAE Systems

As the leading UK company involved in the production of each F-35, most of the manufacturing for the fighter jet takes place across England, but BAE Systems still has other major manufacturing hubs across Scotland, including Govan and Scotstoun in Glasgow.
